


LOOK AT OUR PROGRESS!

REMOVING BARRIERS & INCREASING ACCESS



At present, Georgia Military College provides site based instruction to students on the campuses of Mundy's Mill and North Clayton High Schools. As a result, all barriers to transportation are removed thereby increasing access to the Dual Enrollment Program.

Superintendent, Dr. Morcease J. Beasley, supports the collaborative efforts to increase the number of collegiate courses taught on the campuses of high schools. In the very near future, Clayton County Public Schools' teachers will have the option of serving as Adjunct Professors. They will teach collegiate courses throughout the school year furthering the ability of students to have access to the program.

Advanced Placement (AP) offers college-level curricula and examinations to high school students. In May 2018, high school students from various grade levels took AP exams. The results are in, and Clayton County's students have made gains! This year, 19.4% of our students earned a qualifying score of 3 or higher - a 3 percentage point gain from last year's 16.4%. Students scoring a 3, 4, or 5 on an AP exam have proven themselves capable of doing the work of an introductory level college course in a particular subject area. We are extremely proud of our schools' and students' determination and hard work.



As we remain committed to high performance, we look forward to continuing the trend of increasing student achievement during the 2018-2019 school year!
